## SINACH'S BIOGRAPHY

Sinach, whose full name is Osinachi Kalu Okoro Egbu, was born on March 30, 1972, in Ebonyi State, Nigeria to Mr. and Mrs. FK Okoro. She is the second of seven children. Born in a Christian home her father was an accomplished civilian servant and her mum is a retired educationist. These helped set a good example of Christian and educational background.

She had her primary and high school education in Ebonyi State where she came out in flying colors. She later went to the Federal university of Port-Harcourt where she graduated in B.Ed. Physics in 1993.

Sinach has always identified with singing, acting and writing from a young age, but began living purposefully after she gave her life to Jesus Christ – a decision which positioned her for an upward trajectory in life and gave purpose to her music, making it a viable tool to influence the world.

Sinach has distinguished herself as a global success, having recorded several landmark high points in her music till date. She set a new world record by being the first black African woman to top the Christian Songwriter chart on Billboard for 10 straight weeks in 2020. With 4 versions of her songs in the top 20 songs on Billboard and 2 in the top 10, and after recently bagging 3 nominations at the 51st GMA Dove Awards, world-renown worship leader and Gospel Music singer/songwriter, Sinach, has established her over 30-year ministry as one of the hallmarks of this generation. Sinach also received the highly acclaimed BMI award for the gospel music song of the year 2021.

As the lockdowns eased up 2020 in the USA, Sinach toured several cities in America which contributed significantly to restoring hope and strengthening the citizens' faith in Jesus Christ. Sinach's impact was recognized by the 18th Congressional District of Texas and California who remarked "...your tireless efforts are completely deserving of the respect, administration, and commendation of the United States Congress"

Her song, Way Maker, is a go-to music for healing, hope and restoration all around the world. It was sung on the streets, in hospitals, at malls, everywhere, whilst going viral on the internet every other week. It has over 60 registered different versions in many languages.

Sinach was recently awarded one of the most influential African women on earth, having been recognized at other times as one of the 100 most reputable persons on earth.

She headlined a Way-Maker tour, which took her to over 56 countries and 89 cities in 3 years, including United States of America, United Kingdom, Canada, India, Brazil, Australia, New Zealand, Jamaica, the Bahamas, Surinam, Grenada, Kenya, Seychelles, Zambia, Zimbabwe, South Africa, and many others in countries.

Sinach has led millions around the world in worship and praise to God. This is very evident, with her songs being translated to other languages almost on a daily basis, and having over 60 translations of her music all over the world.

She has great influence on social media platforms of 1.8 Million subscribers on Youtube, 3 Million on Facebook, 1.5 Million of Instagram.

Sinach, currently, is the most streamed Gospel Artist from Africa, with "I Know Who I Am," "He Did It Again," "Great Are You Lord," "The Name of Jesus" and over 50 other songs which have all crossed over 1 million streams on YouTube. On YouTube alone, she has grossed over 640 million views, and on most other streaming platforms like Apple Music, Spotify she charts at the top for Gospel music.

Inducted into the Bethlehem Hall of Fame in 2017, Sinach's music is recognized by many Governments and corporate institutions. As a prolific song writer, she has written over 200 songs, many of which are sung globally in Churches, and has won numerous awards in her home country Nigeria and beyond.

Sinach is on many lists such as the Top 100 Influential Christians in Nigeria, the Western Africa Artist of the Year, African Achievers Award for Global Excellence, Songwriter of the Decade, and several more.

To commemorate her 30 years in music, she partnered with GOSGEM to organize a historic 5 Day Concert, and platformed over 34 singers for the event which still stands as the longest and most featured concert in Nigeria.

In her local church Christ Embassy she's committed years of leading worship and through these times, she won numerous awards for excellence and commitment such as song of the year, artist of the decade, worship song of the year, and lots more at the LoveWorld International Music and Arts Awards.

Documenting myriads of valuable lessons for life and ministry into her first book titled I Know Who I Am, Sinach is dedicated to mentoring young creatives in different aspect of life from all around the world. Her charity Organization has given scholarships to over 100 kids, and she has helped several widows and women set up business in rural communities, as well as supported many old peoples' homes and prisons as she travels across the world in her tours.

In 2014, Sinach got married to Mr. Joseph Egbu, the co-convener of the 5 Days of Unending Thanksgiving, the CEO of GOSGEM and the Chairman of SLIC Inspire. They are blessed with a most beautiful daughter Rhoda.

Her vision is to see the Word of God transform the lives of people all around the world through her music, writing and initiatives.
